Major Recommendations:

- Utilize floorplans to identify kit locations
- · Consider maximizing access to the kits through training
- Don't forget about supplies that expire! (batteries, tape, gloves, etc.)
- Perforated zip-ties and tamper-proof tape can help to minimize supply pilfering while also
- serving as a reminder to do an inventory
- It is useful to maintain both an inventory list online and a physical one within emergency
- kits to mark off used supplies
- Clearly identify leadership for kit maintenance
- Mobility is an incredibly important kit feature
- Be creative when it comes to kit supplies!


